SUBJECT: Section 102 of the Consumer Product Safety Improvement Act (CPSIA) and 16 CFR Part 1700

In November, 2008 Cephalon, Inc. announced our commitment to ensure compliance with the CPSIA's new Requirements for Certificates for Conformity Testing and Third Party Testing. Specifically, Section 102's General Conformity Certificate (GCC), requires that manufacturers (and importers) of all products subject to any standards administered by the Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) furnish certificates for such products. The certificates are to certify that such products comply with all applicable standards of the CPSC, based on a test of each product or upon a reasonable testing program.

Cephalon has successfully completed its project to provide access to compliance documentation for the following products distributed in the United States: AMRIX®, ACTIQ®, FENTORA®, GABITRIL®, NUVIGIL® and PROVIGIL®.
